## The festival is delighted to be able to offer two exhibition spaces in 2010: The Court House and the Victoria Seaman's Hall.

### Receiving day

Saturday 29th May 2010. 10am – 6pm

### Entry Fee

An entry fee of £5 is required for each work.

### Number and size of works

A maximum of two works may be submitted.

Maximum size 5' x 5' including frames.

Sculpture maximum 4' x 2' x 2' on plinth.

### Medium

Works in oil, watercolour, pastel, gouache, acrylic and mixed media; screen prints, drawings, sculpture and photography all accepted.

### Framing

Submissions must be framed in such a way that all glass or Perspex edges are fully covered and protected, clip frames are not acceptable. Appropriate eyelet screws and hanging material to be affixed. Unframed canvases may be submitted at the artists own risk.

### Sculpture

A composite work must be accompanied by clear instructions for assembly. Plinths for sculpture must be supplied with the work. Plinths and packaging must be clearly labelled.

### Labels

A Nairn Book & Arts Festival label must be attached to each work. Part A attached by long string to the back and parts B and C to be handed in at submission. Labels will be issued upon receipt of application form and entry fee.

### Sale of work

All work must be for sale. All sales are subject to 33.3% commission during the Exhibition. The price of works as shown on the label is the total price payable by the purchaser. Artists registered for VAT must enter their VAT number on the labels.

### Selection

Selection will be made by a panel of judges whose decision is final.

### Care of works

While all reasonable care is taken of works submitted, such works are at all times at the artist's own risk. Nairn Book & Arts Festival will not be responsible for any loss or damage however caused, either during or awaiting transit to and from the Exhibition or during any period of storage, packing or unpacking or any period in which work may be in the care and control of Nairn Book & Arts Festival.

### Copyright

Under the Copyright, Designs and Patents Act 1988 it is the general rule that, in the absence of any agreement to the contrary, copyright of a work of art belongs to the artist or his/her heir assigns. Artist should indicate in the appropriate place on the label whether they agree to the reproduction of their work without fee in the Nairn Book & Arts Festival website and other media.

### Collection Points

Collection from Edinburgh, Glasgow and Aberdeen will be arranged at a subsidised charge of £20 return per artist.

### Removal of unselected work

Tuesday 1st June 2010 2pm – 6pm  
Victoria Seaman's Hall or by special arrangement.

### Removal of unsold work

Sunday 20th June 2010 12pm – 4pm  
or by special arrangement.

No work, once selected, can be removed until the close of the exhibition.

Works not collected by 20th June will be removed to storage at the artist's risk and expense.
